Early College - May Graduates 2020 Update as of 4.3.2020

May Graduates Class of 2020 (4-year Senior grads & 5-year SuperSenior grads) High School Diploma Graduation Requirement Courses are:

- 4 English credits (I, II, III, IV)
- 4 Math credits (Math 1, 2, 3 and a 4th math aligned with post high school plans
- 3 Science credits (a physical science, Biology and Earth/Environmental
- 4 Social Studies (Civics & Economics, American History I & II, World History)
- 1 Health and Physical Education Credit
- 2 Elective credits of any combination from either:
 - CTE,
 - Arts Education or
 - World Languages
- 4 Elective credits from the following (4 course concentration recommended):
 - CTE
 - ROTC
 - Arts Education (ex. Dance, music, theater arts, visual arts)
 - Any other subject area of cross-disciplinary courses (ex. Math, Science, Social Studies, English and Dual Enrollment Courses)

Grading and GPA for May Graduates Class of 2020 (only)

- o Fall grades in high school and college courses will count toward GPA on the high school transcript.
- o Spring grades in high school and college courses will not count toward the high school GPA on the high school transcript. BUT, college course grades will be recorded and will count toward the college GPA on the college transcript.
- o Spring high school courses: If students were passing at Spring Break, students will receive a "Pass" (PC19 code) as the final grade in the course on the high school transcript. If students were not passing at Spring Break, students will be provided the opportunity to improve the grade to passing, prior to the end of the course (contact the teacher). Students should continue working, as normal, in the Spring high school courses. There will be no EOCs and NCFEs.
- o Spring college courses: MCC is still taking grades. The actual college grade will be placed on the college transcript. The "Pass" (PC19 code) will be used on the high school transcript (assuming the student passed).
- o PC19 = "Pass" and credit earned; but, it does not count toward high school GPA.
- o The withdrawal process from college courses has not changed. MCC is proceeding with online courses and taking grades.
- Final high school rank for the May 2020 Graduates will come from the high school transcript rank calculation at the end of the 1st Semester (December 2019).
